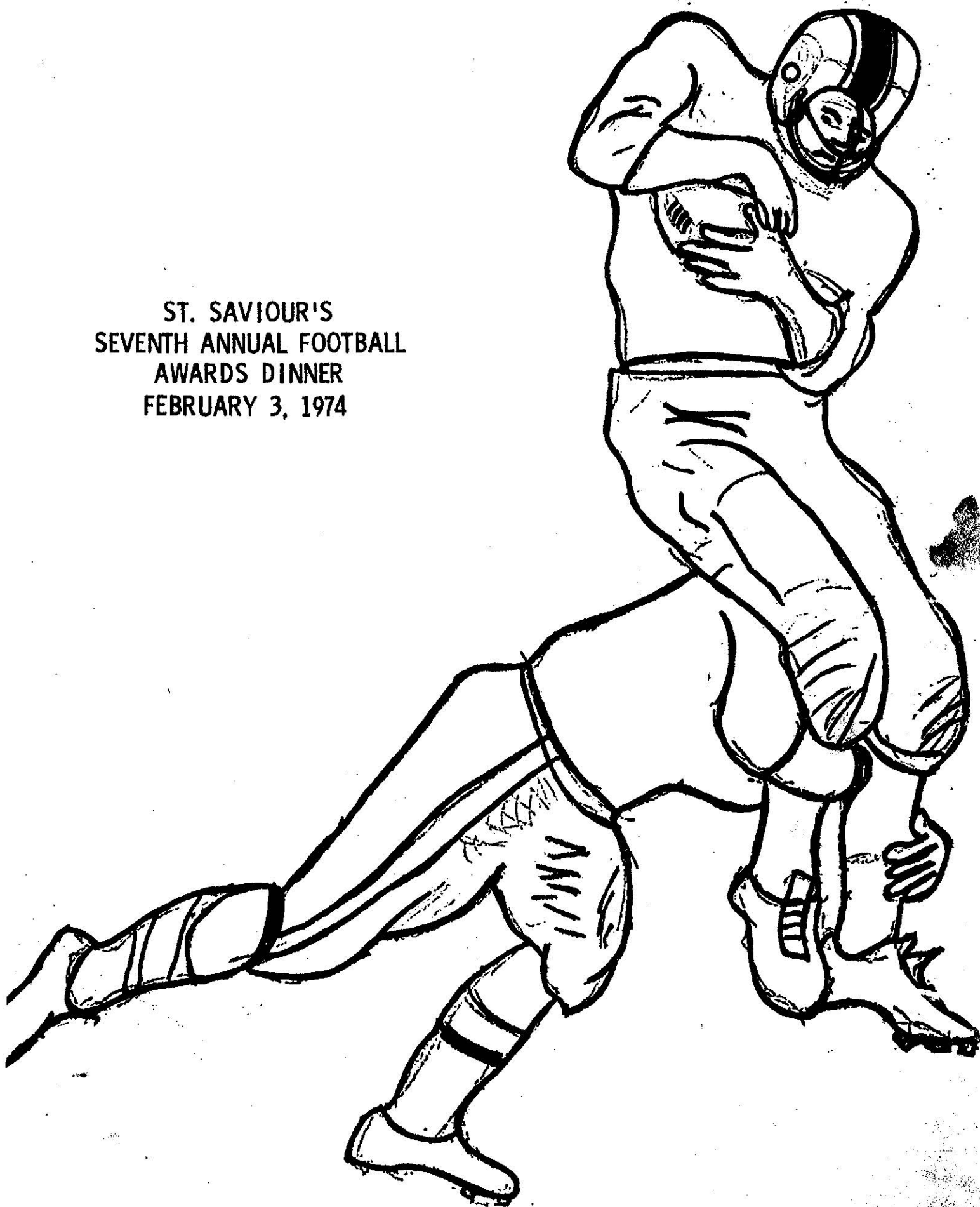


ST. SAVIOUR'S
